



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pershing Gold Corp. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pershing Gold Corp. compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 144% points. The greatest weakness of Pershing Gold Corp. is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 136%, being 221% points above the market average of -85%.
