



The relative strengths and weaknesses of DURECT CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DURECT CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 155% points. The greatest weakness of DURECT CORP is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -48%, being 255% points above the market average of -303%.
