



The relative strengths and weaknesses of PHIBRO ANIMAL HEALTH CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of PHIBRO ANIMAL HEALTH CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 470% points. The greatest weakness of PHIBRO ANIMAL HEALTH CORP is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 290% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 71%, being 348% points above the market average of -276%.
