



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Groupon Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Groupon Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 3.5% points. The greatest weakness of Groupon Inc is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 1.8% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 73%, being 13% points below the market average of 87%.
