



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Federated Hermes INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Federated Hermes INC compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 62% points. The greatest weakness of Federated Hermes INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 126%, being 44% points above the market average of 82%.
