The relative strengths and weaknesses of Midwest Holding INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Midwest Holding INC compared to the market average is the variable Debt Securities, Available-for-sale, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 4.2% points. The greatest weakness of Midwest Holding INC is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 17%, being 0.79% points below the market average of 18%.
