



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pultegroup INC MI are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pultegroup INC MI compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 167% points. The greatest weakness of Pultegroup INC MI is the variable Notes and Loans Payable, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 296%, being 154% points above the market average of 142%.
