



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Jacobs Engineering Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Jacobs Engineering Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points. The greatest weakness of Jacobs Engineering Group Inc is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 152%, being 11% points above the market average of 140%.
