



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Syntel INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Syntel INC compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 82% points. The greatest weakness of Syntel INC is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 374%, being 108% points above the market average of 267%.
