



The relative strengths and weaknesses of IHS Markit Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of IHS Markit Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 194% points. The greatest weakness of IHS Markit Ltd is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 11% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 395%, being 167% points above the market average of 228%.
