



The relative strengths and weaknesses of IAC Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of IAC Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 195% points. The greatest weakness of IAC Inc. is the variable Selling Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.5% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 412%, being 205% points above the market average of 207%.
