



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Onemain Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Onemain Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Deposits, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points. The greatest weakness of Onemain Holdings Inc is the variable Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 62% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 17%, being 0.46% points above the market average of 17%.
