



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Lendingtree Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Lendingtree Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points. The greatest weakness of Lendingtree Inc is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 132% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 33%, being 16% points above the market average of 17%.
