



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Jones Financial Companies Llp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Jones Financial Companies Llp compared to the market average is the variable Financial Securities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 104% points. The greatest weakness of Jones Financial Companies Llp is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 139% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 7.7%, being 147% points below the market average of 154%.
