



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Federal Express CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Federal Express CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 64% points. The greatest weakness of Federal Express CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 102%, being 25% points above the market average of 77%.
