



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Seneca Global FUND L P are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Seneca Global FUND L P compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of Seneca Global FUND L P is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 173%, being 37% points above the market average of 136%.
