

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National Holdings CORP Rank 52 of 103

The relative strengths and weaknesses of National Holdings CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of National Holdings CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 151% points. The greatest weakness of National Holdings CORP is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 380% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 152%, being 8.4% points above the market average of 143%.
