



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bullish Fund are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bullish Fund compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 59% points. The greatest weakness of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bullish Fund is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.5% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 196%, being 61% points above the market average of 135%.
