

## TD Ameritrade Holding CORP Rank 71 of 85

The relative strengths and weaknesses of TD Ameritrade Holding CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of TD Ameritrade Holding CORP compared to the market average is the variable Receivables, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points. The greatest weakness of TD Ameritrade Holding CORP is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 92% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 67%, being 77% points below the market average of 145%.
