



The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Oil Fund LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Oil Fund LP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of United States Oil Fund LP is the variable Other Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 5.3% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 175%, being 32% points above the market average of 143%.
