The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Brent Oil Fund LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Brent Oil Fund LP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of United States Brent Oil Fund LP is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 24% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 201%, being 58% points above the market average of 143%.
