



The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points. The greatest weakness of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 83% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 276%, being 113% points above the market average of 163%.
