



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Millburn Multi-Markets Fund L.P. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Millburn Multi-Markets Fund L.P. compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 71% points. The greatest weakness of Millburn Multi-Markets Fund L.P. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 237%, being 105% points above the market average of 132%.
