The greatest strength of United States Brent Oil Fund LP compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of United States Brent Oil Fund LP is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 152%, being 20% points above the market average of 133%.
