



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bearish FUND are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bearish FUND compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points. The greatest weakness of Invesco DB US Dollar Index Bearish FUND is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 194%, being 50% points above the market average of 144%.
