The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Gasoline Fund LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Gasoline Fund LP compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 94% points. The greatest weakness of United States Gasoline Fund LP is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 248% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 279%, being 135% points above the market average of 144%.
