



The relative strengths and weaknesses of CAMPBELL FUND TRUST are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CAMPBELL FUND TRUST compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 108% points. The greatest weakness of CAMPBELL FUND TRUST is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 327%, being 122% points above the market average of 205%.
