The greatest strength of Cboe Global Markets Inc compared to the market average is the variable Goodwill And Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points. The greatest weakness of Cboe Global Markets Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 108%, being 41% points below the market average of 149%.
