The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Gasoline Fund LP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Gasoline Fund LP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 63% points. The greatest weakness of United States Gasoline Fund LP is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 5.9% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 187%, being 57% points above the market average of 130%.
