



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Vaneck Merk Gold ETF are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Vaneck Merk Gold ETF compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 85% points. The greatest weakness of Vaneck Merk Gold ETF is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 222%, being 102% points above the market average of 120%.
