



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Celanese Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Celanese Corp compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of Celanese Corp is the variable Cost of Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 168%, being 35% points above the market average of 133%.
