





The relative strengths and weaknesses of MYERS INDUSTRIES INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of MYERS INDUSTRIES INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 304% points. The greatest weakness of MYERS INDUSTRIES INC is the variable Cost of Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 135% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 242%, being 227% points above the market average of 15%.
