



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Celanese Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Celanese Corp compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of Celanese Corp is the variable Other Compr. Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 1.2% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 175%, being 55% points above the market average of 121%.
