


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Xerox Holdings Corp Rank 14 of 29



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Xerox Holdings Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Xerox Holdings Corp compared to the market average is the variable Costs of Goods Sold, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 216% points. The greatest weakness of Xerox Holdings Corp is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 295% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 233%, being 46% points above the market average of 186%.
