





The relative strengths and weaknesses of GOLDFIELD CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GOLDFIELD CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points. The greatest weakness of GOLDFIELD CORP is the variable Inventory, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 104%, being 64% points above the market average of 39%.
