











The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cartesian Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cartesian Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 165% points. The greatest weakness of Cartesian Inc. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 121% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -45%, being 21% points above the market average of -66%.
