

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Shutterstock Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Shutterstock Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 129% points. The greatest weakness of Shutterstock Inc. is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 72%, being 125% points above the market average of -53%.
