



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Shutterstock Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Shutterstock Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points. The greatest weakness of Shutterstock Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 62%, being 84% points above the market average of -22%.
