



The relative strengths and weaknesses of GoodRx Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GoodRx Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 42% points. The greatest weakness of GoodRx Holdings Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 55%, being 91% points above the market average of -35%.
