





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Franklin Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Franklin Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 26% points. The greatest weakness of Franklin Resources INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 133%, being 28% points above the market average of 105%.
