



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Janus Capital Group INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Janus Capital Group INC compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 13% points. The greatest weakness of Janus Capital Group INC is the variable Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.1% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 98%, being 2.9% points below the market average of 101%.
