



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Franklin Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Franklin Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points. The greatest weakness of Franklin Resources INC is the variable Selling and General Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 122%, being 17% points above the market average of 105%.
