



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Westwood Holdings Group INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Westwood Holdings Group INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 43% points. The greatest weakness of Westwood Holdings Group INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 137%, being 32% points above the market average of 105%.
