



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Lazard Group LLC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Lazard Group LLC compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points. The greatest weakness of Lazard Group LLC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 84%, being 21% points below the market average of 105%.
