



The relative strengths and weaknesses of CCUR Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CCUR Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of CCUR Holdings Inc is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 105%, being 6.2% points above the market average of 99%.
