



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Westwood Holdings Group INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Westwood Holdings Group INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of Westwood Holdings Group INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 140%, being 41% points above the market average of 99%.
