



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Biopower Operations Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Biopower Operations Corp compared to the market average is the variable Operating and Employee Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 2.6% points. The greatest weakness of Biopower Operations Corp is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 43% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 2.6%, being 97% points below the market average of 99%.
