



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 34% points. The greatest weakness of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 146% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 35%, being 56% points below the market average of 91%.
