





The relative strengths and weaknesses of SECURITY NATIONAL FINANCIAL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of SECURITY NATIONAL FINANCIAL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points. The greatest weakness of SECURITY NATIONAL FINANCIAL CORP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 140% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 32%, being 30% points below the market average of 62%.
