





The relative strengths and weaknesses of VALUE LINE INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of VALUE LINE INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of VALUE LINE INC is the variable Operating and Employee Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 104%, being 42% points above the market average of 62%.
